The Director of GetMedicare responded by phone stating that they would check the warehouse and come back with an update on stock. They asked for delivery location for shipping information. In the meantime, another provider confirmed availability of stock and as the products are time sensitive in terms of stockouts, an official order was placed with Trigiene Dental for the goods.</p> <p>However, later on Thursday afternoon (4th June 2020) GetMedicare rang back and advised that they had stock and had already shipped the items to the delivery address, free of charge as they wanted to support the family and the NHS for a fantastic job during this difficult time. AGEM nor the CCG had requested or agreed for them to do this. They had acted on their own initiative and sent the items to the address submitted for quotation. The Director also stated that he wanted to make a donation to the family which Arden GEM's Transactional Lead advised was a kind gesture, but not permitted with the NHS. It was very generous to have donated the products and the CCG was alerted to the fact that this had happened.</p> <p>On Saturday 6th June, GetMedicare sent an email to the Transactional team advising that the items had been delivered and that he had made the financial contribution to the family for a wheelchair and wanted to support them going forwards.</p>	AGEM nor the CCG accepted the offer of free products or have been involved in the acceptance of any financial benefits to the family.
